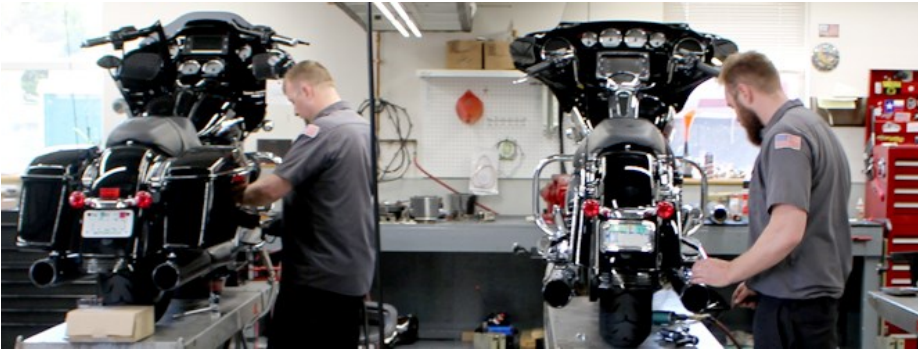


MOTORCYCLE MAINTENANCE & REPAIR

Certificate

The goal of the program is to prepare the student to work in the increasingly sophisticated and complex field of motorcycle technology through a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on skill development. Technicians must be able to work with electronic diagnostic equipment, read and understand technical manuals, investigate to find the cause of a problem, and connect effectively with the customer. Students will use a variety of tools, including both manual and high tech equipment to assess, identify problems, and perform repairs.

Great Bay offers a unique training opportunity with classes held at Seacoast Harley Davidson in North Hampton New Hampshire. Students learn from active Master Level Technicians in a state-of-the-art lab using current motorcycles and equipment. This program is offered 3 days per week during the daytime for all 3 semesters.

- Complete an application to the certificate
- Provide official copy of High School completion or equivalent (GED/HiSet Scores)
- Applicant must possess and provide a valid motorcycle license.
