- Must have completed with a "C" or better

 - o Biology
 - o Chemistry

□ ATI TEAS Exam

• Complete the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)* with a minimum Total Score of 66% or higher.

GBCC's ATI TEAS Testing Policy- Applicants are permitted to take the TEAS exam three times per 12-month period. Test dates must be at least 30 days apart. Test scores are valid for a period of two years. Scores may not be combined or averaged from multiple attempts. Scores must be received by the deadline.

*The ATI TEAS Pre-Entrance Exam is designed to identify areas that may need strengthening before a prospective student begins the major course of study in Nursing. To receive information regarding the ATI TEAS Pre-Entrance Exam or to register for a specific exam date, contact ATI at <u>www.atitesting.com</u>.

Special consideration points are given to applicants who:

- Have completed college-level Human Anatomy Physiology I and/or II prior to the February 28th deadline with a grade of "C+" within the past 5 years from the time of acceptance.
- Are a current or former Health Occupation student from a CTE high school program prior to the February 28th deadline.
- Is an active LPN, LNA/MNA, CNA, MA, Paramedic, or EMT (Submit a copy of your license/certification with your name and expiration date.)
